2009 PROGRAM OVERVIEW

TEE-LO Golf, Inc, a 501(c) 3 organization, (EIN: 59-3735699) is a community-based program for young people to learn the game of life through the game of golf. The organization seeks to engage young people ages 7 -17 years in learning golf skills, etiquette, and helping them to transfer those lessons to daily life.

This "grass roots" program charges no fees to its students to participate. "No Fees" is a key element of our program's mission. Our coaches and staff are all volunteers. We exist on donations and through resources provided by sponsors, parents and various fund raising activities.

TEE-LO Golf is now recruiting students for our 2009 program. We encourage parents to support their children's efforts by attending scheduled events and participating in TEE-LO activities. The 2009 program has been structured to teach beginning concepts to our new students and provide continued and advanced training to our existing base of students. We are striving to make "gentlemen and gentlewomen" of all our students.

There are two sessions in the 2009 program:

Session I: January 30 – June 26

Session II: August 14 – October 23

Program Schedule: *All classes meet every week unless otherwise notified.*

Classroom Instruction by PGA Professionals

Wednesday 6:00pm – 7:30pm

Beginners: golf swing practice

Intermediate: skill development

Advanced: strategy training

Friday 6:30pm – 8:00pm

1st and 3rd Friday: Golf Instruction

2nd Friday: Life Skills Instruction

4th Friday: PIZZA PARTY and Guest Speaker

Business Dress is required on all 4th Friday meetings

Gentlemen: shirt & tie (coat optional), dress shoes

Gentlewomen: dress or skirt and blouse, dress shoes

At the Wednesday sessions, students will be able to reinforce their fundamental skills by practicing at the newly built golf training facility located at the Rosen Tangelo Park YMCA. The training facility will be used to help beginner students hone their putting techniques. The Intermediate students will continue to develop their chipping and pitching skills while reinforcing their putting skills as needed. The advanced students will be provided an opportunity to learn more about the strategy of the game. All students will have access to a golf professional for guidance and instruction in needed areas of development.

In the Friday night classroom sessions, students learn the rules of golf and personal values that enhance their ability to excel at golf and in life. On the fourth Friday of each month, guest speakers are invited to speak to the students about their careers and/or professions and how they have accomplished their goals while relating their experience with the game of golf. Parents are strongly encouraged to attend these sessions.

Saturday 10:00am – 12:00pm: Beginners (TEE-LO Training Facility – TP YMCA)

Saturday 2:00pm – 3:00pm: Intermediate (locations may vary)

Saturday 1:00pm – 6:00pm: Advanced (locations may vary)

4th Saturday – no course instruction

Golf instruction will include rules, course etiquette, and training by PGA Professional in golf skills such as club grip, body stance, swing mechanics, and playing strategies. These sessions will be held at the course specified during the Friday night classroom instruction until the training facility is completed.

The program consists of three classes: beginners, intermediate, and advanced. The beginners' class is designed for those students who have never played golf and /or have minimal skills. To progress to the next class, a student must master the basic golf essentials such as etiquette, club handling, and golf terminology. The intermediate class progresses to the advanced level after demonstrating the ability to perform in competition, significant improvement in golf skills and knowledge, and displaying leadership characteristics. The advanced class must demonstrate leadership skills and characteristics and will be required to assist the Friday night instructor with class preparation, class demonstration, and instruction participation. The advanced students will rotate this responsibility on a weekly basis dependent upon the direction of the Instructor.

Supervised play is held at 1 of three golf courses.

- **Celebration Golf Course:** a regulation par 72 - 18 hole championship golf course that was designed by Robert Trent Jones, Jr., and includes a driving range, practice putting green, a three-hole grid course three par 3 practice holes which our program uses
- **North Shore Golf Course:** a magnificent 18 hole, par 72 golf course with 3 sets of tees, for recreational and novice golfers while advanced players can test their skills on 6900 yards of challenging golf
- **Orange County National:** two championship courses (Panther Lake & Crooked Cat), a 9 hole short course (Tooth), several onsite instruction schools and the largest driving range and practice facility in America
- **Orange Lake Resort & Country Club:** 18-hole "Legends" course at the facility in Kissimmee, Florida features 7,072 yards of golf from the longest tees for a par of 72. The course rating is 74.3 and it has a slope rating of 132 on Bermuda grass. Designed by Arnold Palmer/Ed Seay, ASGCA, the Legends golf course opened in 1982

Students are grouped by ability and/or previous scores with an adult volunteer and are allowed to play either the front nine or the entire 18 hole course.

* *Supervised play is for course ready students only – (able to hit the ball 50 yards in the air)*

Program Completion Expectations

Graduates of the 2009 program will understand the basic rules of golf. They are expected to be proficient at playing the golf course from 100 yards in. Our program is ongoing. Students who are course ready have course access opportunities most weeks of the calendar year (even when our formal program is in recess). We also have discount passes at the Orange Lake Golf Club Facility year round for both parents and students. Our students do not technically complete our program until their eighteenth birthday. The TEE-LO program is continuing for students 7 – 17. After the first year of program basics, students are encouraged to stay in the program to continue to improve their skills as golfers and as gentlemen and gentlewomen.

***The TEE-LO Golf training facility is adjacent to the Harris Rosen YMCA in Tangelo Park.*
